Day 00 :	MUMBAI TO VIETNAM	Assemble at Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport to board the flight for VIETNAM.	-----
Day 01 :	ARRIVAL AT HANOI & HANOI CITY TOUR	Welcome to Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam. Upon arrival, you will be greeted by a local tour guide and taken to the city center. Check in to your hotel. In the afternoon, visit Ba Dinh Square - the largest square in Hanoi where all the city's biggest cultural, political events, especially demonstrations, take place. Start our tour at the Ho Chi Minh Campus including the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (only from the outside because it closes in the afternoon), Ho Chi Minh's house-on-stilts, his fish pond and the One-Pillar Pagoda. Then, the Temple of Literature which is considered to be Vietnam's first university. Next, we take an overall view of the capital by cyclo in 1 hour, walking around the old quarter of Hanoi and Hoan Kiem Lake ('Sword' Lake). From here, experience the daily life of the locals by walking around the narrow streets of the old quarter. Return to your hotel. Overnight in Hanoi. Suggested night activities: Enjoy local beer on Ta Hien Streets, live music, experience the sleepless street atmosphere with young Hanoi people and foreign tourists. Hundreds of bars and pubs are also available to you in the Old Quarter or just spend your time in shopping malls or various boutique shops. Spend the night in Hanoi.	DEPARTURE DATE -----
Day 02 :	HANOI - HALONG - OVERNIGHT ON CRUISE - SHUTTLE BUS	Breakfast at hotel then check out. At 9am, head East for 3 hours driving to Halong Bay, the pride of the Gulf of Tonkin, a Natural World Heritage as designated by UNESCO in 1994 and 2006. The road will pass by the Red River delta with green paddyfields and rural villages, where hard-work farmers are busy with their farming jobs, ploughing buffaloes or planting seedling. Upon arrival in Halong, check in the overnight cruise to discover the magnificent beauty of this  Descending-dragon  bay, created by thousands odd-shaped limestone rocks and karst grottoes. After a lunch on board, we can visit the Grottos, stop for swimming or kayaking, passing floating houses and approach islets to enjoy their beauty in close distance. Back to the cruise, enjoy cooking demonstration before having dinner. Evening attend activities on the boat or relax at your own leisure. Overnight on the cruise.	 
Day 03 :	HALONG BAY TO HANOI - SHUTLLE BUS	You should wake up early to enjoy the dawn on the sea in the early morning. The Vietnamese call the "East Sea" by a point-oriented name "Eastern Sea", so you may guess how miraculous seeing the sunrise over the islets of the Bay. After breakfast our boat will continue to cruise in marvelous areas, where almost each islet has its own name, adopting its shape or reminiscent like Sail Island, Fisherman  s head rock, Butterfly rock or Turtle islet etc. Check out your room and have brunch on board while the cruise coming back the pier. Disembark from the cruise, transfer back to Hanoi. Check in hotel. Your time at leisure. Overnight in Hanoi.	 
Day 04 :	HANOI - MORNING FLIGHT TO DANANG - HOIAN ANCIENT TOWN	Breakfast at hotel then check out. Transfer to the airport with driver only (no guide) to board a flight to Danang. Upon arrival, welcomed by the local tour guide and transfer to check in hotel by the beach (The normal check in time is 14:00-15:00). Afternoon, transfer to Hoian Town. You take interesting walk over the tile-roofed Japanese Bridge, visit taciturn Chinese Assembly Halls, enjoy the attractiveness of ancient houses or listen to folk music of Central Vietnam at old club-houses. Later we can stop at shrines or stroll into the market located by Thu Bon river, where you may find the same feelings of the artists, who see the rooftops of Hoian a magical old world of Oriental feel and source of inspiration. This is also a wonderful town to shop for lanterns, soft silk, raw silk, or get your clothes tailored within a day. Transfer back to Danang. Overnight in Danang.	
Day 05 :	DANANG - BA NA HILL - DANANG	Breakfast at hotel Morning transfer to Ba Na Hill, one of the most spectacular landscape of Danang City. You will take a cable car to the summit of mountain (at 1487m of sea level). Start visiting Ba Na Hill with many different attractions: Funicular, Debay ancient wine cellar & Le Jardin D  Amour, Linh Ung pagoda, Thich Ca Buddhist statue, etc. This afternoon you continue to join activities and games in Fantasy Park. Later walk to the summit of the mountain at the height 1487m  the highest one of Ba Na Mountain, visit Bell Tower, Nghinh Phong tower and Golden Bridge, to take beautiful photos of the mountain and Da Nang city. Late afternoon, taking the cable car back to foothill. back to hotel. Time at leisure. Overnight in Danang. (Please note: Wax Museum, cotton animal game and carnival skill at Fantasy Park is not included in our tour cost, joining them will be at your own account.)	

Day 06 : DANANG - MORNING FLIGHT SAIGON - CITY TOUR

Have breakfast at the hotel and then check out. Transfer to the airport with driver only (no guide) to fly to Ho Chi Minh City, also known as Saigon, Vietnam's most dynamic city. Upon arrival, welcomed by local tour guide and transferred to downtown. Check in at your hotel (normal check in time is 2 pm). Start the city tour at War Remnants Museum, one of Saigon's most famous historical attractions. By visiting War Remnants Museum, you can learn how Vietnamese people struggled and fought for their freedom, independence and peace of the nation and the local people's view of the Vietnam War. Exhibits such as weapons, documents and photos displayed in the museum are solid evidence of war crimes in Vietnam and speak of the heroic deeds of former Vietnamese generations. Near the Palace is Notre Dame Cathedral (view from outside only), built between 1877 and 1883 and the colonial-style Central Post Office, which is one of the city's main landmarks. Late afternoon, visit Ben Thanh market, which is a symbol of Saigon. Shop there. Spend the night in Saigon.

Day 07 : SAIGON - CU CHI TUNNELS

After Breakfast, drive to Cu Chi Tunnels - a network of over 200km of tunnels became famous when they played a key role in the war. In their heyday, the tunnels were operating underground cities including many trap doors, specially built living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centers and kitchens. After a short introduction video showing how the tunnels were built, you will have the chance to crawl into a small section of the tunnels to feel the oppressive narrowness and heat inside. After lunch (at own expense), return to Saigon. The afternoon is your free time to relax or go sightseeing/shopping around the city. Overnight in Saigon.

Day 08 : SAIGON - DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel. Time at leisure until check out time and transfer to the airport (no guide) for the departure flight back to your sweet home.

This Tour starts with Dinner on Day 01 and Ends with Breakfast on Day 08.

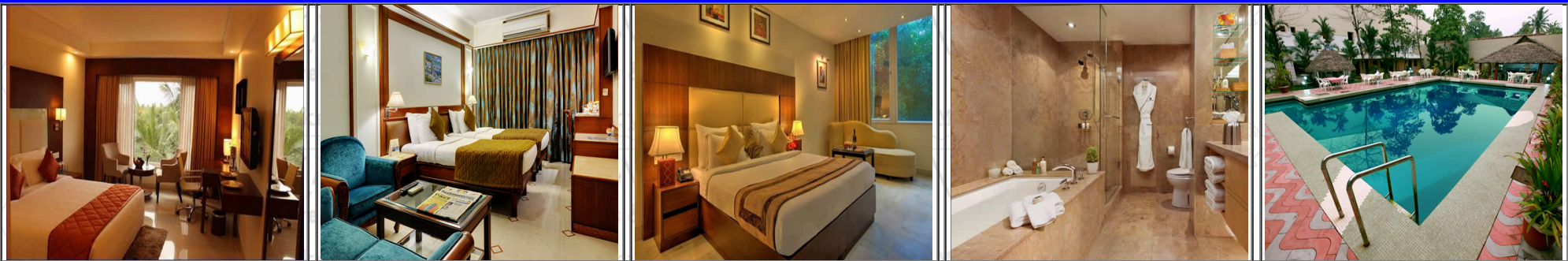

- **Hanoi** :- Hanoi is a resolute survivor of the many wars fought on its land and is now the capital of Vietnam. The city is packed with rustic beauty and romance and lies on the banks of the Red River. It is culturally and economically growing at a rapid rate and is a mix of old-age charm and a modern cosmopolitan outlook.A vast metropolis - Hanoi still holds relics of its French-occupied past in its French Quarters, and displays a distinguished class in its Old Quarter, centred around the Hoan Kiem Lake. It is a postcard-perfect vision of stunning pagodas, peaceful boulevards, and upbeat streets with sumptuous food options.This charming capital was also awarded the title of 'City of Peace' by the UNESCO in 1999. Bustling with crowd and voices, it is rich in culture with ever-growing infrastructure. Also known as - 'City of Lakes', about two dozens of such water bodies add to the beauty of this already gorgeous city.Amid the thriving economy and a continuing sense of transition, there is a strong essence of nostalgia apparent all over Hanoi. No wonder then that it is also called 'Paris of the East'! Sample the art scene, munch on the cuisine and bathe in the relaxed vibe of the city of Hanoi.
- **Ho Chi Minh City** :- Commonly referred as Saigon, Ho Chi Minh City is all about dynamism, crowded streets, skyscrapers and urbanization fusing well with culture side including Oriental style pagodas, ancient temples and traditional markets. With a sudden bout of economic uprising, the city offers something for everyone and thus serving as a destination worth visiting.The largest city of Vietnam and a former capital of the Republic of Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh is a city buzzing with frantic energy all the time. Once tagged as the Pearl of the Orient by French, today it is a great blend of little chaos and peace, crowded streets and tiny hidden alleyways, sky touching office buildings and ancient structures. Nestled on the banks of Saigon River, the place is thriving as to-be metropolis serving as county's major commerce hub. One can witness the success story of the city through its posh restaurants, luxury hotels, numerous bars and clubs and showrooms selling premium goods. The lifestyle of Ho Chi Minh is on open display all the time with most of the living rooms opening on to the street, people zooming around on motorcycles, and chatting and napping in the parks. The cosmopolitan city is vibrant, rich in food, fast paced and with a dash of romance displayed in French architecture. The city also offers a wide range of tourist attraction from historic buildings such as war-related museums and elegant pagodas defining their history to beautiful shopping malls.
- **Halong Bay** :- Halong Bay is a popular bay which is located in the north of Vietnam. The name of this place i.e. Halong means "the place of descending dragons". This place was not very much known before the 19th century. However in the recent years the popularity of this place has risen to a much greater value.It is a beautiful bay which one can visit in order to enjoy the scenic beauty present all around.Halong Bay is one of the famous regions of Vietnam. This bay is known to be located on the northern side of Vietnam and is also known as the land of the descending dragons. A newspaper in the 18th century reported sighting a dragon on its shore due to which this bay has got this name. This bay is known to contain around 1000 islands some of which are inhabited while some of them have been left vacant. You can easily access most of these islands through ports and you would be mesmerised by the beauty of each island as well as the bay altogether. This bay has been declared as a protected sight by the UNSECO and some parts

of this bay are not accesible as development of these areas is underway. You would find numerous toursits at this place during the months of May to August and over the years this has become one of the most loved destinations of the world.

- **Da Nang** :- With broad beaches, fantastic street food, the fabled Hai Van Pass, and a growing collection of cafes, restaurants, and bars, it’s no wonder the residents of Da Nang sport some of the broadest smiles in the country. The warm sands of My Khe Beach sweep south from the mountainous Son Tra Peninsula. Da Nang hosts some of Vietnam's top luxury resorts, but much of the beach still belongs to the people who make it their playground, gym, and source of livelihood.
- **Enjoy the beach**
Be sure to set the alarm clock early at least once on your stay. Along the shore, fishermen sell the day’s catch, football and volleyball matches spring up all around, and people jog, stroll or simply relax on the sand.
- **See the Son Tra Peninsula**
The Son Tra Peninsula strikes out into the ocean, its densely forested hillsides are home to the endangered red-shanked douc langur -- one of the world’s most striking primates. Grab some binoculars, hire a motorbike, and head out for a day of wildlife spotting.
- **Learn about Cham culture**
The Cham people once ruled much of Central Vietnam, and ruins of their temples have been excavated around Da Nang. The superb Cham Museum of Sculpture houses the largest collection of Cham sculpture in the world.
- **Dine on street food**
Da Nang is a dream destination for foodies, with scores of seafront eateries and street food stalls. Mi Quang – a dish of rice noodles, pork, shrimp, quail eggs, peanuts and fresh herbs – is must-try delight.
- **Explore Marble Mountains**
Marble Mountains is a collection of five outcrops topped with atmospheric pagodas, only 15 minutes from the city. Set out in the early morning to take a serene walk up stone steps, explore hidden caves, and admire ancient shrines.
- **Da Nang Weather**
Da Nang is a great destination year-round. However, the best months to visit are from March to May and September to October, when the weather is warm. June to August sees little rain and the sea is clear and calm. The rainy season from November to February brings long rains and moody weather.
- **Da Nang Transport**
The Da Nang International Airport has several daily connections to major cities in Vietnam. There are also a growing number of international connecting flights. Trains and buses pass through Da Nang, making it a convenient travel hub to explore the central region. In town, taxis are abundant, as well as ride-hailing apps. Popular trips from Da Nang are easily arranged, whether heading to Marble Mountain, Son Tra Peninsula, Hoi An, or Hai Van Pass, motorbike or car tours are readily available.
